LA CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT ERIC GARCETTI WILL SPEAK TO JAYCEES
SFV Jaycees will host Councilman Garcetti at next member meeting

SAN FERNANDO VALLEY – One of the City’s youngest ever Council members, Council President Eric Garcetti, will be the featured speaker at the San Fernando Valley Jaycees membership meeting, 6:30 p.m., Tuesday July 24th at the Valley Economic Development Center (VEDC) located at 5121 Van Nuys Boulevard, in Sherman Oaks.

Each month, San Fernando Valley Chapter Jaycees (Junior Chamber) members gather to develop as leaders of the Valley through networking, participating in community service projects and learning from guest speakers. This month’s speaker is no exception. The epitome of a “young leader” in Los Angeles, Council President Garcetti is a Rockefeller Foundation Next Generation Leadership Fellow and a recipient of the John F. Kennedy New Frontier Award for Americans under 40 who are changing their communities with a commitment to public service. He will discuss his approach to being a leader and impacting the community.

Prior to his election, the Councilman taught public policy, diplomacy and world affairs at Occidental College and the University of Southern California. He studied urban planning and political science at Columbia University, receiving his B.A. and M.A. degrees in International Relations, and is Rhodes Scholar of Oxford University and also studied at the London School of Economics.
